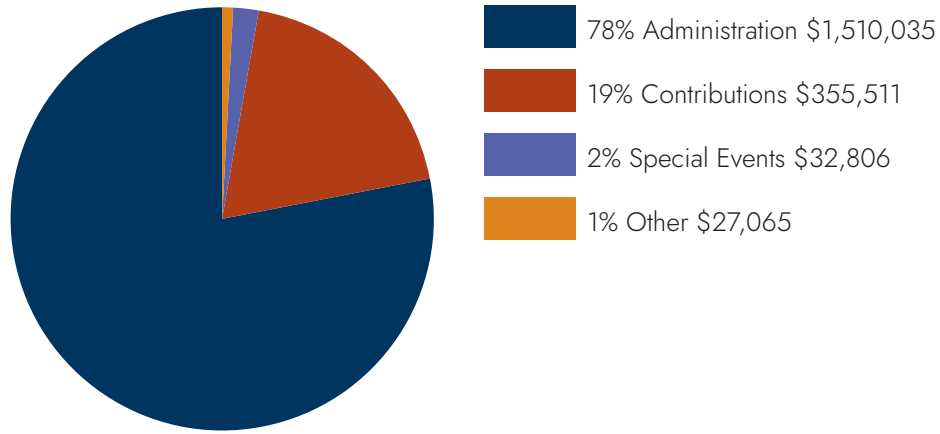

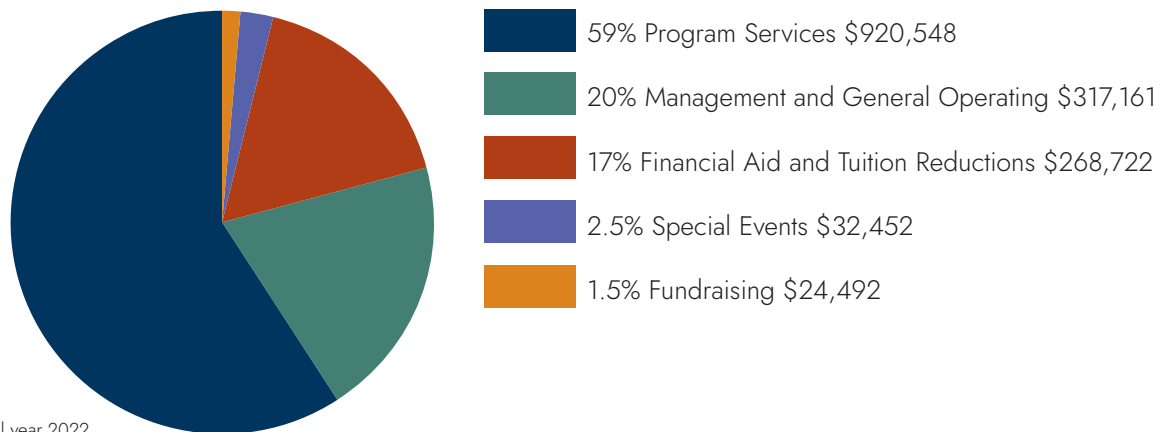
2021–22 REVENUE*
